Check your mail! Ballots began to be mailed to registered voters on October 5. Once received, you can cast your voted mail ballot with a pre-paid envelope in the mail, at an early vote site, at ballot drop-box location, or at any polling place.

VOTE EARLY

Excited to cast your voted mail ballot but want to deliver it personally? You don't have to wait until Election Day! The Registrar of Voters office, located at 777 East Rialto Avenue in San Bernardino, will operate as an early vote site beginning October 5. Five additional early vote sites will be open from October 26 to 30.

Avoid lines at polling places! Voters can now cast their voted mail ballot with a pre-paid envelope in the mail, at an early vote site, at 70 ballot drop-box locations throughout the county, or at any polling place.



MAILING IN YOUR BALLOT

Mailing in your ballot? We've got you covered. Each mail ballot has prepaid postage so you don't have to worry about stamps! Just make sure your ballot is postmarked by Tuesday, November 3, 2020 for it to be counted! Oh, and don't forget to sign the outside of the envelope where instructed.

Have you voted yet? Vote early to avoid lines and crowds on Election Day. If you still want to vote a polls ballot in-person, California is allowing registered voters to cast a ballot any of the four days between October 31 to November 3 at a polling place.

This year, voters have more options than ever before and voting early is one option. Whether you prefer mail, drop-off or in-person, casting your ballot early means avoiding lines at a polling place on November 3. How cool is that?!
