Parade of Lights

Beginning Monday, December 11<sup>th</sup> and continuing through Tuesday December 19th, the Colton & Loma Linda Fire Departments will be presenting our annual "Parade of Lights". At dusk, Fire units adorned with Christmas lights will caravan throughout the neighborhoods and escort Santa Claus on a decorated sleigh. Candy canes will be distributed to the children by Santa and Fire Department personnel. Residents should be aware that the use of emergency sirens will announce the parade in each neighborhood. In order to cover all areas of both Cities, the parade will be conducted on nine separate nights.

### **Neighborhood Schedule**

#### **COLTON**

Monday, December 11<sup>th</sup> – Downtown area and northeast section of the City (Between 7<sup>th</sup> Street & Harbor, and from Valley to Johnston)

Tuesday, December 12<sup>th</sup> – Northwest portion of City (from Valley to Mill, and Teresa to 8<sup>th</sup> Street)

Wednesday, December 13<sup>th</sup> - West end of the City (from Valley to Randall; Meridian to Sycamore)

Thursday, December 14<sup>th</sup> – La Loma Hills and South Colton

Friday, December 15<sup>th</sup> - Cooley Ranch area

Saturday, December 16<sup>th</sup> - Reche Canyon area

### **LOMA LINDA**

Sunday, December 17th – North West end of Loma Linda (North of Barton, South of I-10 FWY, East of Oakwood, West of Mt View)

Monday, December 18th – North East Portion of Loma Linda – (North of Barton, South of I-10, East of Mt View, West of California, Barton Vineyards and Oasis townhomes will be included on this night)

Tuesday, December 19<sup>th</sup>- South end of Loma Linda- (South of Barton, North of Beaumont Avenue, West of Laurel Avenue, East of Oakwood)
